



Swimming Lessons -Years 2-4 2021

Dear Parents/Caregivers

One strand of our Physical Education programme is swimming. This is a requirement of the New Zealand Curriculum and, as we do not have our own pool, our students will attend the local pool at Albany Stadium Pool for a series of 5 half hour lessons with qualified instructors. The students will be split into ability groups to be taken at their level to build confidence and learn water safety skills. All abilities will be catered for.

Please note we only take students in Years 2 – 6. This ensures that the Year 1 classes keep to their newly established school routines.

Rooms 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 27 and 28 will go every school day from Monday 1-5 March

Rooms 23, 24, 25, 26, 29 and 30 will go every school day from Monday 8 – 12 March

We will be travelling by bus.

The children will need their togs, towel, a swimming or plastic bag, swimming cap (compulsory) and goggles (if they wish) every day. Swimming caps will be available for sale from the school office closer to the time.

Unfortunately parents are not permitted to watch lessons due to Health and Safety requirements.

The cost for the lessons including transport is \$40.00. Please ensure that this is paid via Kindo before your child attends their first lesson.

There are ability questions and permission for your child to swim that must be completed and you can access this via Kindo.
